A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to hunting, trapping, or fishing, so as to change certain provisions relating to game
- 3 and fish license, permit, tag, and stamp fees; to provide effective dates; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.
