## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending University System of Georgia Outstanding Scholar James Lewis Metts of East  
2 Georgia College on Academic Recognition Day for 2008; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Georgia's educational system is dedicated to the goal of providing a quality  
4 education to all and fostering the realization of each person's fullest potential; and

5 WHEREAS, the 35 institutions of the University System of Georgia are valuable resources  
6 for the people of this state, enhancing the intellectual, economic, social, civic, and cultural
