## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Sherry Saunders; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Sherry Saunders served with distinction for three years as service unit director  
3 for the Camilla Rose Service Unit of the Girls Scouts, after having served previously as a  
4 troop leader; and
