AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide for enforcement of state laws pertaining to functions assigned to the Department
- 2 of Agriculture; to provide for certain other enforcement powers of department employees;
- 3 to amend Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 4 Annotated, relating to control of infectious or contagious diseases in livestock generally, and
- 5 Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department
- 6 of Agriculture, so as to redesignate and change certain provisions relating to enforcement of
- 7 laws relating to control of infectious or contagious diseases in livestock generally; to repeal
- 8 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

10 SECTION 1.

- 11 Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating
- 12 to control of infectious or contagious diseases in livestock generally, and Chapter 2 of Title
- 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department of Agriculture, are
- amended by redesignating and revising Code Section 4-4-5, relating to enforcement of laws
- 15 relating to control of infectious or contagious diseases in livestock generally, as follows:
- 16 "4-4-5 <u>2-2-13</u>.

- 17 (a) The Commissioner is shall be vested with police powers to enforce this chapter all state
- 18 <u>laws pertaining to functions assigned to the department</u> and the rules and regulations
- adopted pursuant to this chapter thereto.
- 20 (b) The Commissioner is shall be authorized to employ, designate, and deputize, homeland
- 21 <u>security investigators</u> and <u>to</u> delegate to <u>such</u> employees of the department the necessary
- 22 authority to enforce this chapter all state laws pertaining to functions assigned to the
- 23 <u>department</u> and the rules and regulations adopted pursuant to this chapter thereto. The first
- 24 <u>priority of such investigators shall be to investigate potential threats, if any, to homeland</u>
- 25 <u>security if and when such investigations are otherwise authorized under this subsection.</u>
- 26 Employees who have been so designated by the Commissioner and who have been certified

by the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council as having successfully

- 2 completed the course of training required by Chapter 8 of Title 35, the 'Georgia Peace
- 3 Officer Standards and Training Act,' are shall be authorized:
- 4 (1) To carry firearms authorized or issued by the Commissioner while in the performance
- 5 of their duties;
- 6 (2) To enforce all state laws pertaining to functions assigned to the department, including
- 7 <u>but not limited to the following powers:</u>
- 8 (2)(A) To inspect any livestock found within this state plants, animals, or products
- 9 when the same are subject to regulation by the department;
- 10 (3)(B) To stop and inspect any vehicle transporting livestock in this state; plants,
- animals, or products when the same are subject to regulation by the department; and
- 12 (4)(C) To inspect and require the production of health certificates, waybills, permits,
- or other documents required by federal or state laws, rules, regulations, or orders for the
- transportation of livestock plants, animals, or products when the same are subject to
- regulation by the department;
- 16 (3) To enforce all state laws on all property owned or controlled by the department;
- provided, however, that the department's exercise of police powers at the Atlanta State
- Farmers' Market in Forest Park shall be as provided by Code Section 2-10-57;
- 19 (4) To enforce any state law when the violation of that law is committed in conjunction
- with a violation of a state law pertaining to functions assigned to the department;
- 21 (5) To enforce any state law when ordered to do so by the Governor or to protect any life
- or property when the circumstances demand action;
- 23 (6) To assist, at the expense of the department, the Georgia Office of Homeland Security
- or the Georgia Bureau of Investigation in carrying out their duties and responsibilities
- 25 when requested to do so by the Georgia Office of Homeland Security or the Georgia
- 26 <u>Bureau of Investigation; and</u>
- 27 (5)(7) To arrest any person found to be in violation of this chapter any state law, the
- 28 <u>enforcement of which is authorized by paragraphs (2) through (6) of this subsection,</u>
- 29 <u>when such violation is a criminal offense</u>.
- 30 (c) From funds appropriated or available to the department, the Commissioner is shall be
- 31 authorized to provide motor vehicles, uniforms, firearms, and any other equipment and
- supplies needed by employees of the department to carry out this chapter Code section.
- 33 (d) This Code section shall not repeal, supersede, alter, or affect the power of any other
- law enforcement officer of this state or of any county, municipality, or other political
- 35 subdivision of this state to enforce this chapter state laws pertaining to functions assigned
- 36 <u>to the department</u>. At the request of the Commissioner of Agriculture, it shall be the duty
- of all state, county, municipal, and other law enforcement officers in this state to enforce

and to assist the Commissioner and the employees and agents of the department in the

2 enforcement of this chapter state laws pertaining to functions assigned to the department."

3 SECTION 2.

4 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
