A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and commending George Coleman and inviting him to appear before the House
2 of Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, George Coleman currently serves as Vice-President of Operations and
4 Development for Homeland Self Storage and, prior to taking such position, honorably served
5 as Chief of Police for the Fulton County Police Department from 1999 through 2007; and

6 WHEREAS, George Coleman has a long and distinguished history of service to his country
7 as demonstrated by his service as a patrol officer, detective, sergeant, lieutenant, captain,
8 major, and deputy chief of police for the Fulton County Police Department; and

9 WHEREAS, he has also successfully completed advanced officer courses of study and
10 training in the area of investigation and executive development; and his commitment to the
11 community is further demonstrated by his active membership in many civic groups and
12 associations and the leadership role he has provided by serving on a variety of law
13 enforcement boards and subcommittees; and

14 WHEREAS, George Coleman is also most noted for his tremendous and long-standing
15 support for the Georgia International Law Enforcement Exchange (GILEE) program and for
16 his service as a corporate partner board member for GILEE; and

17 WHEREAS, with the support of talented people like Mr. Coleman, GILEE has been able to
18 grow and develop first-rate programs for the national and international exchange of
19 outstanding law enforcement personnel, allowing such expert police officers and public
20 safety leaders to learn from each other through hands-on meetings and operations around the
21 country and around the world; and

22 WHEREAS, George Coleman has gone above and beyond the call of duty to guarantee the
23 success of each program he has worked with and the safety of those individuals coming

1 together to fight crime and he has loyally and diligently answered the call of duty, often with
2 great personal sacrifice and risk to his own safety; and

3 WHEREAS, this exceptional officer exhibits outstanding leadership, patriotism, courage, and
4 dedication to his country and to the world community, and the State of Georgia owes a debt
5 of gratitude to this man of extraordinary character; and

6 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that this man who has personally contributed so
7 much to public safety and security be appropriately recognized.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
9 the members of this body honor and commend George Coleman for his outstanding service
10 to the State of Georgia, to the United States, and to world peace.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that George Coleman is invited to appear before the House
12 of Representatives at a date and time to be determined by the Speaker for the purposes of
13 being recognized by the House and receiving an appropriate copy of this resolution.
