#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Randy Harrison for his support of the Georgia International  
2 Law Enforcement Exchange and inviting him to appear before the House of Representatives;  
3 and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Randy Harrison has outstandingly served as the Director of Corporate Security  
5 for Delta Air Lines, Inc., a major American airline headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Harrison has had a long and distinguished career with Delta beginning in  
7 1990; he was appointed director of Environmental Services worldwide in 2000; in 2006, he  
8 was awarded one of only two Environmental Lifetime Achievement awards ever presented  
9 by Delta; and also in 2006, he was appointed Director of Corporate Security and in a short  
10 time realigned Delta's security philosophy and structure to meet its changing business model  
11 and global concerns; and

12 WHEREAS, Randy Harrison is also most noted for his tremendous and long-standing  
13 support for the Georgia International Law Enforcement Exchange (GILEE) program and his  
14 service as a corporate partner board member for GILEE; and

15 WHEREAS, with the support of talented people like Mr. Harrison , GILEE has been able to  
16 grow and develop first-rate programs for the national and international exchange of  
17 outstanding law enforcement personnel, allowing such expert police officers and public  
18 safety leaders to learn from each other through hands-on meetings and operations around the  
19 country and around the world; and

20 WHEREAS, the valuable support of Randy Harrison and others has helped GILEE achieve  
21 a state, national, and international reputation as a leader in the exchange of law enforcement  
22 ideas and initiatives; and

1 WHEREAS, such an exchange of information has led to the tremendous growth of effective  
2 public safety initiatives around the globe, thereby increasing national security and world  
3 peace and generally making our world a better and safer place; and

4 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that this man who has personally contributed so  
5 much to public safety and security be appropriately recognized.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
7 the members of this body honor and commend Randy Harrison for his outstanding service  
8 to the State of Georgia, to the United States, and to world peace.
