A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 47-2-266 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 certain judicial employees' membership in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia
- 3 and contributions, so as to provide that a person who is a member of such retirement system

- employees' membership in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia and contributions,
- 12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 13 "(g) Any member who is a member of this retirement system by operation of subparagraph
- (a)(1)(D) of this Code section may receive up to four years of creditable service under this
- 15 chapter for past service as a full-time law assistant for a judicial circuit employed pursuant
- to the provisions of Code Section 15-6-28 upon payment to the board of trustees of such
- amount as determined by the actuary as necessary to grant such benefit without creating
- any accrued actuarial liability as to this retirement system. Such payment shall be made
- not later than July 1, 2009, or within six months of first or again becoming a member,
- whichever is later."

- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008, only if it is determined to have been
- 23 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 24 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not

1 become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2008, as

2 required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

3 SECTION 3.

4 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
