### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending CMSGT Donald Neal Paschal on the occasion of his  
2 retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, CMSGT Donald Neal Paschal will retire on the May 1, 2008, after 35 years and  
4 six months and 15 days of military service to the State of Georgia and its citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, CMSGT Paschal was born in Atlanta, Georgia, on the October 5, 1949, and is  
6 now a resident of Centerville, Georgia and a member of the Georgia Air National Guard  
7 assigned to the 116th Air Control Wing (JSTARS) at Robins Air Base; and

8 WHEREAS, CMSGT Paschal entered service with the Georgia Department of Defense on  
9 October 16, 1972, and completed his basic training at Lackland Air Force Base in San  
10 Antonio, Texas; and

11 WHEREAS, upon completion of training he returned to Georgia to serve the citizens when  
12 called upon by the Governor during peacetime, conflict, and natural disasters; and

13 WHEREAS, CMSGT Paschal in his career with the Georgia Air National Guard has worked  
14 with various aircraft, including C-124 GLOBEMASTER II, the F-100 SUPER SABRE, the  
15 F-105G THUNDERCHIEF, the F-4D PHANTOM, the F-15A EAGLE, the B1-B LANCER,  
16 and the E-8C JOINT STARS; and

17 WHEREAS, he has traveled to the Azores, Spain, Greece, Turkey, Germany, France,  
18 Austria, the Republic of Georgia, Luxembourg, Indonesia, Malaysia, Japan, and Canada in  
19 support of the Georgia Air National Guard mission; and

20 WHEREAS, he has three wonderful children; Lindsay who is a full-time mother, Daniel who  
21 currently serves in the Georgia Air National Guard, and Lauren who is a student at the

1 University of West Georgia, and they all have learned from him the meaning of service to  
2 the state and its citizens; and

3 WHEREAS, CMSGT Paschal has provided vast amounts of knowledge and mentorship to  
4 commanders, co-workers, and airmen under his leadership; and

5 WHEREAS, CMSGT Paschal provides community support by volunteering locally as a  
6 volunteer driver for Meals-On-Wheels, coaching Little League in his area, and working with  
7 nearby schools to improve education.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
9 join together in recognizing CMSGT Donald Neal Paschal for his exemplary service to the  
10 country, the state, and its citizens and express to him their sincerest best wishes for the  
11 future.
