A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the State Court of Cobb County, approved March 26, 1964 (Ga.  
2 L. 1964, p. 3211), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 29, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007,  
3 p. 4136), so as to change the compensations of the clerk and the chief deputy clerk of the  
4 State Court of Cobb County; to provide for an effective date; to provide for related matters;  
5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating the State Court of Cobb County, approved March 26, 1964 (Ga. L. 1964, p.  
9 3211), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 29, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 4136),  
10 is amended by striking paragraph (4) of subsection (b) of Section 17, which reads as follows:

11 "(4) The salary of the chief deputy clerk shall be \$91,769.60 to be paid in equal monthly  
12 installments from funds of Cobb County.",

13 and inserting in lieu thereof a new paragraph (4) to read as follows:

14 "(4) The salary of the chief deputy clerk shall be \$95,440.38 to be paid in equal monthly  
15 installments from funds of Cobb County."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 Said Act is further amended by striking from Section 23 the following:

18 "The clerk of the State Court of Cobb County shall receive an annual salary of \$101,966.14  
19 payable in equal monthly installments from the funds of Cobb County.",

20 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

21 "The clerk of the State Court of Cobb County shall receive an annual salary of \$106,044.78  
22 payable in equal monthly installments from the funds of Cobb County."

1 **SECTION 3.**

2 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
3 without such approval.

4 **SECTION 4.**

5 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
