

1 Senators Hill of the 32nd and Douglas of the 17th offered the following amendment:

2 *Amend the Senate Public Safety Committee substitute to SB 25 (LC 35 0747S) by inserting*
3 *after "vehicle;" on line 5 of page 1 the following:*

4 to provide for the issuance to certain businesses of special license plates for persons with
5 disabilities for business vehicles used by disabled employees of such businesses;

6 *By inserting a new Section 2A on page 2 between lines 7 and 8 to read as follows:*

7 **SECTION 2A.**

8 Said title is further amended in Code Section 40-2-74, relating to special license plates for
9 persons with disabilities, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

10 "(a.1) Any business registered in Georgia that is a sole proprietorship, an S Corporation
11 under Subchapter S of Chapter 1 of the Internal Revenue Code, or a single principal limited
12 liability corporation or limited liability partnership which assigns or makes available a
13 passenger motor vehicle for the use of an employee of such business, upon complying with
14 the motor vehicle laws relating to registration, licensing, and payment of fees and upon
15 submitting an affidavit of a practitioner of the healing arts stating that such employee is a
16 person with disabilities, as defined in paragraph (5) of Code Section 40-6-221, whose
17 disability or incapacity can be expected to last for more than 180 days and stating the
18 specific disability that limits or impairs the ability to walk, shall be issued a specially
19 designated disabled person's license plate from the commissioner. The affidavit shall also
20 state that such business vehicle shall be used only or primarily by such disabled employee.
21 In the event that an employee or other person that is not a disabled person uses a business
22 vehicle which has been issued a special plate pursuant to this subsection, he or she shall not
23 avail himself or herself of the privileges afforded under this title to a disabled person with
24 a special plate. Any person who is not a disabled person as prescribed by this Code section
25 and who willfully and falsely avails himself or herself of the privileges afforded to such
26 special plate under this title shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Any business to which one
27 or more special plates are issued pursuant to this subsection which is determined by the
28 commissioner to have repeated violations of this subsection by an employee or employees
29 or other person or persons that are not disabled person as prescribed by this Code section
30 shall be subject to revocation of such special plate or plates."
