

Senate Bill 512

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, relating to the Georgia Student Finance Authority, so as to provide for grants to  
3 students attending North Georgia College who accept a military commission; to provide for  
4 legislative findings; to provide for a definition; to provide for the amount of the grant; to  
5 provide for application for grants, certification of eligibility, and refunds; to provide for a pro  
6 rata reduction when funds are insufficient; to provide for audits of the college; to provide for  
7 a penalty for false statements; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and  
8 for other purposes.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

10 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

11 Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
12 relating to the Georgia Student Finance Authority, is amended by adding a new subpart to  
13 read as follows:

15 20-3-440.

16 The General Assembly finds that it is essential for the national defense that persons be  
17 encouraged to consider military leadership positions as an honorable and rewarding  
18 profession and that North Georgia College, Georgia's only state supported military college,  
19 plays a significant role in preparing and training students for professional life in the  
20 military as a profession. It is the purpose of the General Assembly, as provided for in this  
21 subpart, to encourage students to enroll in North Georgia College and its military training  
22 program and to encourage such students to accept military commissions by providing for  
23 tuition grant assistance to such students.

1 20-3-441.

2 For purposes of this subpart, the term 'eligible student' shall mean a person who:

3 (1) Is enrolled in or accepted for enrollment in North Georgia College for a minimum  
4 of 12 academic hours;

5 (2) Is or will be a citizen of this state for a period of at least 12 months immediately prior  
6 to the date of registration therein;

7 (3) Is enrolled in or plans to enroll in the Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps  
8 program at North Georgia College; and

9 (4) Has signed a contract to accept a commission, to be effective upon graduation, no  
10 later than the end of the student's junior year as an officer in the Army, Army Reserve,  
11 or Army National Guard.

12 20-3-442.

13 There is granted to each eligible student attending North Georgia College the sum of  
14 \$1,500.00 per academic semester.

15 20-3-443.

16 Each eligible student wishing to receive the grant provided for in this subpart shall submit  
17 to North Georgia College an application for the grant payment at the time and in  
18 accordance with procedures prescribed by the authority. The authority is authorized to  
19 define such terms and prescribe such rules, regulations, and procedures as may be  
20 reasonable and necessary to carry out the purposes of this subpart. The authority shall not  
21 approve payment of any grant until it has received from an appropriate officer of North  
22 Georgia College a certification that the student applying for the grant is an eligible student.  
23 Upon timely receipt of such certification, in proper form, the authority is authorized to pay  
24 the grant to North Georgia College on behalf of and to the credit of the student. In the event  
25 a student on whose behalf a grant is paid shall not enroll as a full-time student for the  
26 school term for which the grant is paid, North Georgia College shall make a refund to the  
27 authority in accordance with regulations of the authority.

28 20-3-444.

29 In the event funds available to the authority are not sufficient to enable the authority to pay  
30 on behalf of eligible students the full grant prescribed by the General Assembly, grants  
31 payable for the remaining school terms shall be reduced by the authority on a pro rata basis.

1 20-3-445.  
2 North Georgia College shall be subject to examination by the state auditor for the sole  
3 purpose of determining whether the school has properly certified eligibility and enrollment  
4 of students and credited grants paid on behalf of such students. However, nothing in this  
5 subpart shall be construed to interfere with the authority of the school to determine  
6 admissibility of students or to control its own curriculum, philosophy, purpose, or  
7 administration. In the event it is determined that the school knowingly or through error  
8 certified an ineligible student to be eligible for a grant under this subpart, the amount of the  
9 grant paid to the school pursuant to such certification shall be refunded by the school to the  
10 authority.

11 20-3-446.  
12 Any person who knowingly makes or furnishes any false statement or misrepresentation  
13 or who accepts such statement or misrepresentation knowing it to be false for the purpose  
14 of enabling an ineligible student to obtain wrongfully a grant under this subpart shall be  
15 guilty of a misdemeanor."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
