A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 9-11-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 process under the Civil Practice Act, so as to provide for certain limitations on the time for
- 3 service; to amend certain provisions relating to service; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 9-11-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to process under
- 8 the Civil Practice Act, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 9 "(m) Service Time limit. Where a defendant is not served within 120 days following the
- filing of the complaint, the court, upon motion or on its own without a motion, following
- 11 notice to the plaintiff and an opportunity for plaintiff to be heard, may dismiss the action
- without prejudice or extend the period of time allowed for service. The court shall extend
- the time for service for a reasonable period of time upon a showing of good cause by a
- plaintiff for the failure to serve a defendant."
- 15 **SECTION 2.**
- 16 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008.
- 17 SECTION 3.
- 18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
