## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that the counties of this state
- 2 shall not be bound by any future general law of this state requiring the expenditure of county
- 3 funds at any time when the General Assembly has not appropriated and made available to
- 4 the counties sufficient funds to enable the counties to comply with such law; to provide for
- 5 submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article III, Section VI of the Constitution is amended by adding a new Paragraph VIII to read
- 9 as follows:

- 10 "Paragraph VIII. *Unfunded mandates to counties not binding.* The counties of this state
- shall not be bound by any general law of this state requiring the expenditure of county
- funds at any time when the General Assembly has not appropriated and made available to
- the counties sufficient funds to enable the counties to comply with such law. This
- Paragraph shall apply only with respect to general laws enacted after January 1, 2009."

15 SECTION 2.

- 16 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 17 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 18 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 19 "( ) YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that the
- counties of this state shall not be bound by any future general law of this
- 21 () NO state requiring the expenditure of county funds at any time when the
- General Assembly has not appropriated and made available to the counties
- sufficient funds to enable the counties to comply with such law?"
- 24 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 25 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If

2 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
