## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Mrs. Robena Juliatt Gaines Flakes as the recipient of the Rosa Parks Woman  
2 of Courage Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Robena Juliatt Gaines Flakes is the recipient of the Rosa Parks Woman  
4 of Courage Award from Sisters, Inc., of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Flakes was born in Phenix City, Alabama, the oldest of eight children born  
6 to Mr. and Mrs. Napoleon Gaines, and she is a descendant of John Wesley Gains, the founder  
7 of Morris Brown College in Atlanta, Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, she attended Fifth Avenue School and Radcliff School in Columbus, Georgia,  
9 and graduated from South Girard High School in Phenix City, Alabama; and

10 WHEREAS, she studied early childhood education at Morris Brown College and Columbus  
11 State University and has also attended the Americus Baptist Theology College at Friendship  
12 Baptist Church; and

13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Flakes was a business owner in North Phenix City for 15 years and  
14 employed with the Muscogee County School System at Reese Road Elementary School for  
15 eight years; and

16 WHEREAS, she has always had a deep passion for the welfare of children and that passion  
17 drove her to establish the Fourth Street Day Care Center in Columbus, Georgia, and from  
18 1993 until 2005, she served as its director; and

19 WHEREAS, under her directorship the center grew from serving 56 children to serving 150  
20 children, and it is the first day care center to receive the Center of Distinction Award from  
21 the State of Georgia; and

1 WHEREAS, since her retirement as director, she has served as consultant for the center; and

2 WHEREAS, she is married to the Reverend Dr. J.H. Flakes, Sr., pastor at Fourth Street  
3 Baptist Church in Columbus, Georgia, and they have three children and three grandchildren;

5 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the accomplishments of this remarkable  
6 and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
8 the members of this body commend Mrs. Robena Juliatt Gaines Flakes for her many years  
9 of unselfish and dedicated public service, congratulate her on being selected to receive the
