A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise
3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of
4 adjournment for the 2008 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of March
5 4, 2008, through March 27, 2008, shall be as follows:

- 6 Tuesday, March 4 in session for legislative day 27
- 7 Wednesday, March 5 in session for legislative day 28
- 8 Thursday, March 6 in session for legislative day 29
- 9 Friday, March 7, through Monday, March 10 in adjournment
- 10 Tuesday, March 11 in session for legislative day 30
- 11 Wednesday, March 12 in session for legislative day 31
- 12 Thursday, March 13 in session for legislative day 32
- 13 Friday, March 14 through Monday, March 17 in adjournment
- 14 Tuesday, March 18 in session for legislative day 33
- 15 Wednesday, March 19 in session for legislative day 34
- 16 Thursday, March 20 in session for legislative day 35
- 17 Friday, March 21 through Monday, March 24 in adjournment
- 18 Tuesday, March 25 in session for legislative day 36
- 19 Wednesday, March 26 in session for legislative day 37
- 20 Thursday, March 27 in session for legislative day 38

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after March 27, 2008, the periods of adjournment
22 of the 2008 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General
23 Assembly, except that for the remainder of the 2008 regular session, unless otherwise
24 provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close of the
25 legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall
26 reconvene on the following Monday.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for
2 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the
3 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
