A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to general provisions for criminal trespass and damage to property, so
- 3 as to change provisions relating to criminal damage to property in the first degree; to increase
- 4 certain penalties; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to general provisions for criminal trespass and damage to property, is amended by
- 10 revising Code Section 16-7-22, relating to criminal damage to property in the first degree,
- 11 as follows:
- 12 "16-7-22.
- 13 (a) A person commits the offense of criminal damage to property in the first degree when
- 14 he or she:
- 15 (1) Knowingly and without authority interferes with any property in a manner so as to
- endanger human life; or
- 17 (2) Knowingly and without authority and by force or violence interferes with the
- operation of any system of public communication, public transportation, sewerage,
- drainage, water supply, gas, power, or other public utility service or with any constituent
- 20 property thereof.
- 21 (b) A person convicted of the offense of criminal damage to property in the first degree
- in violation of paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of this Code section shall be punished by
- 23 <u>imprisonment for not less than two nor more than 15 years.</u> A person convicted of the
- offense of criminal damage to property in the first degree in violation of paragraph (2) of
- 25 <u>subsection (a) of this Code section</u> shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one
- 26 nor more than ten years."
