8 **SECTION 1.** 9 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from 10 sales and use taxes, is amended by revising subparagraph (A) of paragraph (84) to read as 11 follows: 12 "(84)(A) Notwithstanding any provision of Code Section 48-8-63 to the contrary, from July 1, 2006 the effective date of the amendment to this subparagraph, until June 30, 13 14 2008 2009, sales of tangible personal property used in direct connection with the 15 construction of to a national infantry museum and heritage park facility or sales of tangible personal property used in the construction of a national infantry museum and 16 17 heritage park facility owned or operated by an organization which is exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code." 18
