A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Thomas Reese Holman; and for other purposes.

11 principles, as demonstrated by his Eagle Scout project; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with particularity
13 the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 commend Thomas Reese Holman for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
16 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
17 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
