1 Senators Wiles of the 37th, Shafer of the 48th and Unterman of the 45th offered the

12 (c)(1) Any person desiring to obtain a license as an 'assistant laser practitioner' who does
13 not meet the requirements of paragraph (1) of subsection (b) of this Code section shall
14 also be eligible for a license as an 'assistant laser practitioner' if he or she makes
15 application to the board within six months of the effective date of this article and presents
16 proof that he or she:

17 (A) Prior to the effective date of this article, obtained a minimum of at least 2,000
18 hours of experience in administering cosmetic laser service; and

19 (B) Has received at least three laser certificates from attending laser/intense pulsed
20 light (IPL) courses, directly taught by a licensed physician or certified continuing
21 medical education or continuing education educator.

22 (2) Any person licensed pursuant to paragraph (1) of this subsection shall not perform
23 any cosmetic laser services unless under the direct supervision of a physician licensed
24 under this chapter who is trained in laser modalities.
