A RESOLUTION

3 vital role that he has played in community leadership and his deep personal commitment to
4 the citizens of his community and the State of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his state as evidenced dramatically by his years
7 of dedicated service to his community as a Mason and as a member of the General Assembly
8 of Georgia, where he served as Chairman of the Defense and Veterans Affairs Committee
9 from 1989 through 1991 and Chairman of the Insurance Committee from 1992 through 2002;

- 16 WHEREAS, he has been blessed with two daughters, Kathy and Rhonda; and
- 17 WHEREAS, this beloved individual has exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty,
18 outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, remarkable patience and diplomacy, a keen sense of
19 vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the members of the General Assembly which have
20 earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates and the members of
21 this body in particular; and

1 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
2 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; his loyalty, competency, reliability, and
3 enthusiasm have distinguished his superlative service to this state; and

4 WHEREAS, he has announced that he will not run for another term upon completion of his
5 present term, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments
6 of this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

8 the members of this body commend Jimmy B. Lord for his many decades of efficient,
