A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- To amend Code Section 42-9-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 1
- 2 employees of the parole board, so as to provide that certified parole officers employed by the
- 3 parole board who leave the board under certain conditions may retain their badges; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 5

6 **SECTION 1.**

- 7 Code Section 42-9-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to employees of the
- 8 parole board, is amended by designating the existing provisions as subsection (a) and adding
- 9 a new subsection to read as follows:
- 10 "(b) A certified parole officer leaving the service of the board under honorable conditions
- 11 who has accumulated 20 or more years of service with the board as a certified parole
- 12 officer shall be entitled as part of such employee's compensation to retain his or her board
- issued badge. A certified parole officer employed with the board who is killed in the line 13
- 14 of duty shall be entitled to have his or her board issued badge given to a surviving family
- 15 member. Where a certified parole officer leaves the service of the board due to a disability
- 16 that arose in the line of duty and such disability prevents the parole officer from further
- serving as a peace officer, then such disabled parole officer shall be entitled to retain his 17
- or her board issued badge regardless of the officer's number of years of service with the 19 board. The board is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the implementation
- of this subsection." 20
