## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- sales and use taxes, is amended by revising subparagraph (A) of paragraph (84) to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 "(84)(A) Notwithstanding any provision of Code Section 48-8-63 to the contrary, from
- 13 July 1, 2006 the effective date of the amendment to this subparagraph, until June 30,
- 14 2008 2009, sales of tangible personal property used in direct connection with the
- construction of to a national infantry museum and heritage park facility or sales of
- 16 <u>tangible personal property used in the construction of a national infantry museum and</u>
- 17 <u>heritage park facility owned or operated by an organization which is exempt from</u>
- 18 <u>taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.</u>"

19 SECTION 2.

- 20 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
