## A RESOLUTION

4 opening of Crabdaddy's Seafood Grill on St. Simons Island, Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, they wanted a restaurant that provided down home hospitality combined with

- 7 WHEREAS, not only is Crabdaddy's Grill a dream come true to the Williams family, but  
8 they provide the finest selection of grilled, blackened, steamed, or fried seafood and steaks  
9 in the Southeast; and
- 10 WHEREAS, some of their famous dishes are crab soup, grouper, and bread pudding; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the restaurant operation involves the entire Williams family including Charlie,  
12 Josh, and E. J. Williams, daughter Amy and her husband, Joey Baldwin, granddaughter  
13 Holland Baldwin, and long-time part owner Scott Bradley; and
- 14 WHEREAS, during the summer they hire local teachers to supplement their incomes and  
15 college students to assist them with tuition payments.
