A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Mr. Albert Worriels and commending him on the occasion of his retirement;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Albert Worriels began his career in the paint and body business as a helper
4 for Bowyer Motors Paint and Body Shop in November, 1957, later moving to work for
5 Econoline Paint and to J. B. Bohannon Paint and Body Shop; and

6 WHEREAS, it was while working for J. B. Bohannon Paint and Body Shop that he became
7 inspired to build his own garage in his back yard, where he did freelance paint and body
8 work in his leisure time; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Worriels stepped out in faith, and on April 1, 1976, he purchased a piece
10 of land 300 feet from his home and constructed a shop with a paint booth, opening the doors
11 to Worriels' Paint and Body Shop, which is today known as Total Recovery Auto Body, Inc.;;

13 WHEREAS, over the past 32 years, Mr. Worriels and his brother have partnered several
14 times, running the business together; and

15 WHEREAS, during his 32 years in business, Mr. Worriels has been active in his community,
16 serving the Woodville Community Organization and the school athletic programs at
17 Tompkins High School and Groves High School; as a board member for the Paint and Body
18 Training Program at Secondary Tech; as a member of the apprentice program at Savannah
19 Area Vocational-Technical School, now known as Savannah Technical College; as a sponsor
20 for community Little League Baseball teams; and as a sponsor for both male and female
21 adult softball teams; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Worriels has never advertised for business on billboards, radio, or any
2 marketing company, receiving his revenue from faithful customers who continue to support
3 a body shop that does quality work; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Worriels and his wife have five lovely daughters.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
6 the members of this body join together in recognizing Mr. Albert Worriels, commend him
7 on his outstanding service to his community on the occasion of his upcoming retirement, and
8 wish him the best of health and happiness.
