## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 offenses against public health and morals, so as to change certain provisions relating to
- 3 tattooing; to provide for tattooing near the eye under certain circumstances; to amend
- 4 Chapter 40 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to tattoo studios,
- 5 so as to repeal provisions relating to the repeal of Code Section 16-12-5, relating to tattooing;
- 6 to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to offenses against
- 10 public health and morals, is amended by revising subsection (b) of Code Section 16-12-5,
- 11 relating to tattooing any person near his or her eye, as follows:
- 12 "(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to tattoo the body of any person within any area
- within one inch of the nearest part of the eye socket of such person either of the two folds
- of skin and muscle that can be closed over the exposed portion of the eyeball. Any person
- who violates this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."

SECTION 2.

- 17 Chapter 40 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to tattoo studios,
- is amended by repealing in its entirety Code Section 31-40-10, relating to criminal laws not
- 19 repealed, which reads as follows:
- 20 "31-40-10.
- Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to repeal the provisions of Code Section
- 22 16-12-5."
