- 2 WHEREAS, Judge J. E. "Bo" Earnest is the son of the late Hoke and Vera Earnest and he began his education at FDR school and graduated from Seminole High School in 1960; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he is a loving husband to his wife Jerrie Worsley Earnest, and a devoted father and grandfather to his two sons and three grandchildren; and
- 6 WHEREAS, at the end of 2008, Judge Earnest will have served the citizens of Seminole County for 40 years and is honored that during that time no one has run against him for the past 20 years; and

- 17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
