A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Y. N. and Agnes Myers on the occasion of their 50th wedding anniversary; and
2 for other purposes.

4 in their community through their active involvement in the economic, social, civic, and
5 religious life of Richmond County; and

18 WHEREAS, the devotion, patience, and understanding that they have demonstrated have
19 provided the foundation and framework of success in which all of their family members have
20 developed and flourished; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the selfless deeds and loving devotion
22 of this remarkable couple be appropriately recognized.
