

## Senate Resolution 1199

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Richard "Dick" Pettys on the occasion of his retirement  
2 from *InsiderAdvantageGeorgia* and covering the General Assembly; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Richard "Dick" Pettys was born on November 25, 1946, in Atlanta,  
4 Georgia, and he is a loving husband to Marian Stephanie Suessmith, and a devoted father to  
5 their three sons, Richard R. Pettys, Jr., William H. Pettys II, and Clement N. Pettys; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Richard "Dick" Pettys has long been recognized by the citizens of this state  
7 for the vital role that he has played in political reporting under the gold dome and for his  
8 deep personal commitment to fairness and the accurate dissemination of the news; and

20 outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his endeavors  
21 which have been recognized by his associates under the gold dome and throughout state

2 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, his knowledge of where to go and how to get the  
3 story first, and his ability to work alongside the members of the General Assembly, gaining

6 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for  
7 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; his loyalty, competency, reliability, and

10 commend Mr. Richard "Dick" Pettys for his many decades of efficient, effective, unselfish,
