- 17 WHEREAS, in April 2008, he will take another military leave of absence for a tour of duty
- 18 overseas in support of Operation Enduring Freedom to plan for the mobilization to
- 19 Afghanistan of the Georgia Army National Guard's 48th Brigade; and
- 20 WHEREAS, with his dedication to fighting crime with the GBI and serving his state and
- 21 nation with the Georgia National Guard, Mike Fordham continues to be a devoted husband
- 22 to his lovely wife, Shirley, and a doting father to their son, Michael; and
