## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the University of Georgia's women's golf team for winning  
2 the 2007 SEC Championship and inviting them to appear before the House of  
3 Representatives; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the University of Georgia women's golf team captured its league-leading 11th  
5 SEC Championship; and

6 WHEREAS, Taylor Leon became the Bulldogs' seventh individual champion in women's  
7 golf, and was named SEC Golfer of the Year; and

8 WHEREAS, Todd McCorkle was voted SEC Coach of the Year; and

9 WHEREAS, four of five Lady Bulldog golfers were named All-SEC as Taylor Leon and  
10 Whitney Wade were tabbed to the first team, and Alina Lee and Garrett Phillips were  
11 second-team choices; and

12 WHEREAS, they shot 3-under 285 in the first round of the SEC Championships at Old  
13 Waverly Golf Club in West Point, Mississippi, to grab a six-shot lead over the field, and  
14 went on to expand that advantage in both the second and third rounds to eventually win by  
15 16 strokes; and

16 WHEREAS, Taylor Leon fired a 5-under 67 in the final round of the SECs to overtake  
17 teammate Garrett Phillips, who was the individual leader following both the first and second  
18 rounds, and they finished 1-2 in the individual field; and

19 WHEREAS, the Bulldogs went on to finish eighth at the NCAA Championships, their 19th  
20 top-10 finish in the last 29 years and their eighth in the last ten seasons; and

1 WHEREAS, Taylor Leon was named first-team All-America and Whitney Wade was an  
2 honorable mention All-America selection; and

3 WHEREAS, they surpassed the team stroke average record, and Taylor Leon broke Georgia's  
4 individual stroke average mark.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
6 the members of this body join together to recognize and commend the University of Georgia  
7 women's golf 2007 SEC Champions and their coaches on their outstanding performance and  
8 invite them to appear before this body at a date and time designated by the Speaker of the  
9 House for the purpose of being recognized by the House and receiving an appropriate copy  
10 of this resolution.
