

Senate Bill 558

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend an Act creating a board of commissioners for Banks County, approved August 19, 1916 (Ga. L. 1916, p. 349), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 31, 1965 (Ga. L. 1965, p. 3058), an Act approved March 21, 1970 (Ga. L. 1970, p. 3297), and an Act approved March 15, 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 3999), so as to provide for an increase in the number of members of the board; to provide for the election of members of the board; to provide for related matters; to provide for a referendum; to provide for contingent effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

An Act creating a board of commissioners for Banks County, approved August 19, 1916 (Ga. L. 1916, p. 349), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 31, 1965 (Ga. L. 1965, p. 3058), an Act approved March 21, 1970 (Ga. L. 1970, p. 3297), and an Act approved March 15, 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 3999), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:

"Section 1. The board of commissioners of Banks County is hereby created. Until January 1, 2010, the board shall consist of a chairperson and two other members who shall be qualified voters and bona fide residents of Banks County for a period of not less than six months preceding the date of their election. On and after January 1, 2010, the board shall consist of a chairperson and four other members who shall be qualified voters and bona fide residents of Banks County for a period of not less than six months preceding the date of their election."

SECTION 2.

Said Act is further amended by revising Section 2 as follows:

"Section 2. (a) Until January 1, 2010, the chairperson and other members of the board may reside anywhere in Banks County and shall be nominated and elected by the qualified

1 voters of the entire county. For the purpose of electing the chairperson and other members
2 of such board, there shall be three commissioner posts to be designated Commissioner
3 Post 1, Commissioner Post 2, and Commissioner Post 3. The chairperson shall be elected
4 from Commissioner Post 1 and all candidates for chairperson shall offer for Commissioner
5 Post 1. Candidates for Commissioner Posts 2 and 3 shall designate the post for which they
6 are offering. The chairperson and each member of the board of commissioners in office
7 on the effective date of this Act shall serve until the expiration of his or her respective term
8 of office and until his or her successor is elected and qualified.

9 (b)(1) On and after January 1, 2010, the chairperson may reside anywhere in Banks
10 County and shall be nominated and elected by the qualified voters of the entire county.
11 For the purpose of electing the remaining members of the board of commissioners, Banks
12 County is divided into four commissioner districts. One member of the board shall be
13 elected from each such district. Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4 shall be and
14 correspond to those four numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part
15 of this Act and further identified as Plan Name: bankscc08p2 Plan Type: Local User:
16 staff Administrator: Banks Co.

17 (2) When used in such attachment, the terms 'Tract' and 'BG' (Block Group) shall mean
18 and describe the same geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the Bureau
19 of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia.
20 The separate numeric designations in a Tract description which are underneath a 'BG'
21 heading shall mean and describe individual Blocks within a Block Group as provided in
22 the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for
23 the State of Georgia. Any part of Banks County which is not included in any such district
24 described in that attachment shall be included within that district contiguous to such part
25 which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of
26 2000 for the State of Georgia. Any part of Banks County which is described in that
27 attachment as being in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such
28 district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall
29 instead be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least
30 population according to the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of
31 Georgia. Except as otherwise provided in the description of any commissioner district,
32 whenever the description of such district refers to a named city, it shall mean the
33 geographical boundaries of that city as shown on the census map for the United States
34 decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia.

35 (3) On and after January 1, 2010, the commissioners holding Commissioner Post 2 and
36 Commissioner Post 3 shall represent Commissioner District 1 and Commissioner
37 District 3, respectively. Such commissioners shall serve out the terms to which they were

1 elected and until their successors are elected and qualified. Successors to such
2 commissioners shall be elected by the electors of the entire county at the 2010 state-wide
3 general election and shall take office on January 1, 2011, for a term of four years.
4 Thereafter, successors shall be elected by the electors of the entire county at the
5 November general election immediately preceding the end of their terms of office to take
6 office on January 1 immediately following such election for four-year terms of office and
7 until their successors are elected and qualified.

8 (4) On the Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2009, commissioners
9 shall be elected from Commissioner Districts 2 and 4 by the electors of the entire county
10 in special elections conducted in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 21
11 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code," as now or hereafter amended. Those
12 persons elected in such special elections shall take office on January 1, 2010, for a term
13 of office to end on December 31, 2012, and until their successors are elected and
14 qualified. At the 2012 state-wide November general election, successors to such
15 commissioners shall be elected by the electors of the entire county and shall take office
16 on January 1, 2013, for terms of four years and until their successors are elected and
17 qualified. Thereafter, successors shall be elected by the electors of the entire county at
18 the November general election immediately preceding the end of their terms of office to
19 take office on January 1 immediately following such election for four-year terms of office
20 and until their successors are elected and qualified.

21 (5) On and after January 1, 2010, the chairperson shall serve out the term to which he or
22 she was elected and until his or her successor is elected and qualified. A successor to
23 such chairperson shall be elected by the electors of the entire county at the 2012
24 state-wide general election and shall take office on January 1, 2013, for a term of four
25 years. Thereafter, a successor shall be elected by the electors of the entire county at the
26 November general election immediately preceding the end of the chairperson's term of
27 office to take office on January 1 immediately following such election for a four-year
28 term of office and until his or her successor is elected and qualified.

29 (6) The chairperson may reside anywhere in Banks County. Except for the chairperson,
30 each district commissioner shall be a resident of the geographic area encompassed by the
31 respective commissioner district which he or she represents. Each commissioner shall
32 be elected by a majority of the electors voting in the entire county. A candidate seeking
33 election to the board of commissioners shall identify the seat to which such candidate
34 seeks election at the time of qualifying for election to the office. If the chairperson ceases
35 to be a resident of Banks County or if any district commissioner ceases to be a resident
36 of the commissioner district from which such district commissioner was elected during
37 his or her term of office, such person shall thereby vacate his or her seat on the

commission. All members of the commission shall be nominated and elected pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia Election Code,' as now or hereafter amended."

SECTION 3.

Said Act is further amended by revising Section 6 as follows:

"Section 6. Reserved."

SECTION 4.

Said Act is further amended by revising Section 11 as follows:

"Section 11. (a) The chairperson shall preside at all meetings. It shall be the duty of the chairperson to sign all orders and warrants for the payment of any money out of the county treasury, the same to be countersigned by the clerk of the board of commissioners.

(b) At the first meeting of each year, the board of commissioners shall elect one of their number to serve as vice chairperson. The vice chairperson shall preside in the absence of the chairperson or in case the chairperson is disqualified for cause. A majority of the board shall be a quorum to transact business."

SECTION 5.

Unless prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the election superintendent of Banks County shall call and conduct an election as provided in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the Banks County for approval or rejection. The election superintendent shall conduct that election on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 2008, and shall issue the call and conduct that election as provided by general law. The election superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organ of Banks County. The ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words:

"() YES Shall the Act be approved that changes the form of government in Banks County from a three member commission to a five member commission with four members elected countywide but who must reside and qualify within a commissioner district and a chairperson elected countywide who shall be a full voting member of the board?"

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes cast on such question are for approval of the Act, then Sections 1 through 4 of this Act shall become of full force and effect immediately. If this Act is not so approved or if the election is not

1 conducted as provided in this section, then Sections 1 through 4 of this Act shall not become
2 effective and this Act shall be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately
3 following that election date. The expense of such election shall be borne by Banks County.
4 It shall be the election superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the Secretary of
5 State.

6 **SECTION 6.**

7 The governing authority of Banks County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to be
8 submitted for preclearance under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
9 amended, and such submission shall be made no later than 45 days after the date on which
10 this Act is approved by the Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

11 **SECTION 7.**

12 Except as otherwise provided in Section 5 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon
13 its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

14 **SECTION 8.**

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
