To amend an Act changing the compensation of the clerk of the superior court, the sheriff,
and the judge of the Probate Court of Cobb County from the fee system to the salary system,
approved February 9, 1949 (Ga. L. 1949, p. 427), as amended, particularly by an Act
approved May 29, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 4154), so as to change the compensation of the

5 judge and the clerk of the probate court; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting

6 laws; and for other purposes.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

#### **SECTION 1.**

9 An Act changing the compensation of the clerk of the superior court, the sheriff, and the 10 judge of the Probate Court of Cobb County from the fee system to the salary system, 11 approved February 9, 1949 (Ga. L. 1949, p. 427), as amended, particularly by an Act 12 approved May 29, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 4154), is amended by revising Section 2A as 13 follows:

14 "SECTION 2A.
15 The judge of the Probate Court of Cobb County shall receive an annual salary of
\$117,096.61, to be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Cobb County."

#### **SECTION 2.**

18 Said Act is further amended by revising the second sentence of Section 3 as follows:

19 "The clerk of the probate court shall be compensated in the amount of \$80,975.49 per

20 annum, payable in equal monthly installments from the funds of Cobb County."

#### 21 **SECTION 3.**

This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming lawwithout such approval.
