- 8 Article III, Section II of the Constitution is amended by revising Paragraph V as follows:
- 9 "Paragraph V. Election and term of members. (a) The members of the General
- 10 Assembly shall be elected by the qualified electors of their respective districts for a term
- of two four years and shall serve until the time fixed for the convening of the next General
- 12 Assembly.

- 13 (b) The members of the General Assembly in office on June 30, <del>1983</del> <u>2009</u>, shall serve
- out the remainder of the terms to which elected.
- 15 (c) The first election for members of the General Assembly under this Constitution
- 16 <u>Paragraph</u> shall take place on Tuesday after the first Monday in November, <u>1984</u> <u>2010</u>, and
- subsequent elections biennially on that day until the day of election is changed by law.  $\underline{\underline{In}}$
- the 2010 general election, the members of the General Assembly from even-numbered
- 19 <u>districts shall be elected to two-year terms of office and the members of the General</u>
- 20 <u>Assembly from odd-numbered districts shall be elected to four-year terms of office.</u>
- 21 Thereafter, in all subsequent elections, members of the General Assembly shall be elected
- 22 at the general election immediately preceding the end of their terms of office for four-year
- 23 <u>terms of office.</u>

- 8 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 9 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- become a part of the Constitution of this state.
