

House Bill 1475

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To provide a homestead exemption from Griffin-Spalding County school district ad valorem
2 taxes for educational purposes in the amount of \$10,000.00 of the assessed value of the
3 homestead for residents of that school district who are 65-69 years of age or older after a
4 two-year phase-in period; to provide a homestead exemption from Griffin-Spalding County
5 school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes in the amount of \$20,000.00 of the
6 assessed value of the homestead for residents of that school district who are 70-74 years of
7 age or older after a two-year phase-in period; to provide a homestead exemption from
8 Griffin-Spalding County school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes in the
9 amount of \$30,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for residents of that school
10 district who are 75 years of age or older after a two-year phase-in period; to provide for
11 definitions; to specify the terms and conditions of the exemption and the procedures relating
12 thereto; to provide for applicability; to provide for a referendum, effective dates, and
13 automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

15 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

16 (a) As used in this Act, the term:

17 (1) "Ad valorem taxes for educational purposes" means all ad valorem taxes for
18 educational purposes levied by, for, or on behalf of the Griffin-Spalding County school
19 district, except for any ad valorem taxes to pay interest on and to retire county school
20 district bonded indebtedness.

21 (2) "Homestead" means homestead as defined and qualified in Code Section 48-5-40 of
22 the O.C.G.A., as amended.

23 (b)(1) Each resident of the Griffin-Spalding County school district who is 65 years of age
24 or older on or before January 1 of the year in which application for the exemption under
25 this paragraph is made is granted an exemption on that person's homestead from

1 Griffin-Spalding County school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes as
2 follows:

3 (A) For the taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 2009, and prior to January 1,
4 2010, in the amount of \$5,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead; and

5 (B) For all taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2010, in the amount of
6 \$10,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead.

7 The value of that property in excess of such exempted amount shall remain subject to
8 taxation.

9 (2) Each resident of the Griffin-Spalding County school district who is 70 years of age
10 or older on or before January 1 of the year in which application for the exemption under
11 this paragraph is made is granted an exemption on that person's homestead from
12 Griffin-Spalding County school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes as
13 follows:

14 (A) For the taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 2009, and prior to January 1,
15 2010, in the amount of \$10,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead; and

16 (B) For all taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2010, in the amount of
17 \$20,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead.

18 The value of that property in excess of such exempted amount shall remain subject to
19 taxation.

20 (3) Each resident of the Griffin-Spalding County school district who is 75 years of age
21 or older on or before January 1 of the year in which application for the exemption under
22 this paragraph is made is granted an exemption on that person's homestead from
23 Griffin-Spalding County school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes as
24 follows:

25 (A) For the taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 2009, and prior to January 1,
26 2010, in the amount of \$15,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead; and

27 (B) For all taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2010, in the amount of
28 \$30,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead.

29 The value of that property in excess of such exempted amount shall remain subject to
30 taxation.

31 (4) No person shall be entitled to receive more than one of the exemptions under this
32 subsection.

33 (c) A person shall not receive the homestead exemption granted by subsection (b) of this
34 section unless such person or person's agent files an application with the tax commissioner
35 of Spalding County, giving the person's age and such additional information relative to
36 receiving such exemption as will enable the tax commissioner of Spalding County to make
37 a determination regarding the initial and continuing eligibility of such person for such

1 exemption. The tax commissioner of Spalding County shall provide application forms for
2 this purpose.

3 (d) The exemption shall be claimed and returned as provided in Code Section 48-5-50.1 of
4 the O.C.G.A., as amended. The exemption shall be automatically renewed from year to year
5 as long as the person granted the homestead exemption under subsection (b) of this section
6 occupies the residence as a homestead. After a person has filed the proper application as
7 provided in subsection (c) of this section, it shall not be necessary to make application
8 thereafter for any year, and the exemption shall continue to be allowed to such person. It
9 shall be the duty of any person granted the homestead exemption under subsection (b) of this
10 section to notify the tax commissioner of Spalding County in the event that person for any
11 reason becomes ineligible for that exemption.

12 (e) The exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section shall not apply to or affect any
13 state ad valorem taxes, county ad valorem taxes for county purposes, municipal ad valorem
14 taxes for municipal purposes, or independent school district ad valorem taxes for educational
15 purposes. The homestead exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section shall be in lieu
16 of and not in addition to any other homestead exemption applicable to Griffin-Spalding
17 County school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes.

18 (f) The exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section shall apply to all taxable years
19 beginning on or after January 1, 2009.

SECTION 2.

21 Unless prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the election
22 superintendent of Spalding County shall call and conduct an election as provided in this
23 section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the Spalding County school
24 district for approval or rejection. The election superintendent shall conduct that election on
25 the date of the November, 2008, state-wide general election and shall issue the call and
26 conduct that election as provided by general law. The election superintendent shall cause the
27 date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately
28 preceding the date thereof in the official organ of Spalding County. The ballot shall have
29 written or printed thereon the words:
