A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Mrs. Thelma Eleanor Ross; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thelma Eleanor Ross was recently inducted into the Houston County
3 Teacher Hall of Fame; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Hall of Fame honors those extraordinary teachers who have made a
5 significant difference in the lives of their students; and
- 6 WHEREAS, candidates for the Hall of Fame are judged on their significant, long-term
7 contributions to student success worthy of system-wide recognition; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thelma Eleanor Ross spent 27 years as an outstanding classroom teacher
9 in various Houston County schools, beginning as a second grade teacher, and later teaching
10 eighth grade math and eleventh grade geography, then retiring to Perry, Georgia, in 1972;

- 12 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
13 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; her loyalty, competency, reliability, and
14 enthusiasm have distinguished her superlative service to public education in this state; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
16 distinguished educator be appropriately recognized.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend Mrs. Thelma Eleanor Ross for her many decades of efficient, effective, unselfish,
19 and dedicated service to public education in Georgia.
