

The Senate Higher Education Committee offered the following substitute to HB 919:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 lottery for education, so as to provide for certain duties for the Georgia Lottery Corporation
3 Board of Directors; to provide for certain duties for the Georgia Lottery Corporation's chief
4 executive officer; to provide for a Georgia Lottery Corporation Legislative Oversight
5 Committee; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal
6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to lottery for
9 education, is amended in Code Section 50-27-7, relating to the general duties of the board
10 of directors of the Georgia Lottery Corporation, by revising paragraphs (4) and (5) and
11 adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
12

13 "(4) Adopt regulations, policies, and procedures relating to the conduct of lottery games
14 and as specified in Code Section 50-27-9; ~~and~~
15 (5) Approve, disapprove, amend, or modify any bonuses or incentive packages
16 recommended by the chief executive officer; and
17 ~~(5)(6)~~ Perform such other functions as specified by this chapter."

SECTION 2.

18 Said chapter is further amended by revising paragraph (5) of Code Section 50-27-11, relating
19 to the duties of the chief executive officer, as follows:
20

21 "(5) Prepare a budget, which shall include a detailed accounting of all bonuses and
22 incentive packages proposed by the corporation, for the approval of the board;"

1 (c) Prior to the beginning of the corporation's fiscal year, the Georgia Lottery Corporation
2 shall submit to the oversight committee and to the Governor, or the Governor's designee,
3 a list of the corporation's proposed bonus or incentive packages for that year."

4 **SECTION 5**

5 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2009.

6 **SECTION 6.**

7 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
