A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Georgia Motor Trucking Association on the occasion of
2 its 75th anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Motor Trucking Association was formed in 1933 at the height of
4 the Great Depression by a hardy group of men seeking the betterment of their industry; and

5 WHEREAS, the Georgia Motor Trucking Association has been in existence for 75 years,
6 making it one of the oldest trade associations in Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, the Georgia Motor Trucking Association has been a consistent advocate for
8 improvements to Georgia's highways and in highway safety; and

9 WHEREAS, the Georgia Motor Trucking Association has approximately 1,000 member
10 firms that employ over 300,000 people in Georgia; and

11 WHEREAS, members of the Georgia Motor Trucking Association reside in every county in
12 Georgia; and

13 WHEREAS, the Georgia Motor Trucking Association has trained more than 200,000
14 commercial drivers to aid law enforcement in promoting highway safety and deterring
15 terrorism; and

16 WHEREAS, the Georgia Motor Trucking Association members move more than 80 percent
17 of the truck freight moved in Georgia each year; and

18 WHEREAS, the Georgia Motor Trucking Association has been a tireless advocate for its
19 members' interests at the local, state, and federal levels for the past 75 years; and

1 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with particularity
2 the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary organization.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
4 the members of this body join together to recognize the Georgia Motor Trucking Association
5 on the occasion of its 75th anniversary and commend it for the valuable services it provides
6 to its members and this state.
