A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of and expressing regret at the passing of William R. Flewellen; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on March 7, 2008, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
4 distinguished citizens with the passing of William R. Flewellen; and

5 WHEREAS, this native of Columbus, Georgia, has been long recognized by the citizens of
6 his community for the vital role he played in leadership and for his deep personal
7 commitment to the welfare of the citizens of his community and state; and

8 WHEREAS, a 1969 graduate of William H. Spencer High School, Mr. Flewellen attended
9 Columbus State University and was the proud national president of the William H. Spencer
10 Alumni Association, often going above and beyond the call of duty by reminding every
11 graduate that they should be proud of being a "Spencerian" because of the rich heritage
12 involved in that educational institution; and

13 WHEREAS, he was an active member of Revelation Missionary Baptist Church and its
14 deacons' ministry, a member of the Chattahoochee Valley Sports Hall of Fame, and the
15 Muscogee County Superintendent's Round Table; and

16 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
17 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community as evidenced dramatically by his
18 many years of superlative service as a salesman; and

19 WHEREAS, he was a loving husband to his wife, Annette, and a devoted father to his two
20 sons, Gregory and William, his daughter, Traci, and five grandchildren, Ciara, Kamree,
21 Ashley, William, and Gregory; and

1 WHEREAS, this singular gentleman was a person of magnanimous strengths with an
2 unimpeachable reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
4 the members of this body join together to honor the life of William R. Flewellen and express
5 their deepest and most sincere regret to his family and friends.
