A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Brad Carver; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Brad Carver has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital
3 role that he has played in public service and community leadership and his deep personal
4 commitment to the State of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, he is an attorney with the law firm of Hall, Booth, Smith & Slover, P. C., and
6 previously was with the firms Miller & Martin and Alston & Bird, the Georgia Municipal
7 Association, and the Georgia Power Company, and he is actively serving as a Major in the
8 United States Army Reserves as the personnel officer of the 335th Theater Signal Command,
9 headquartered in East Point, Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, he served tours of duty in Bosnia, Afghanistan, and Iraq, and as a result of his
11 outstanding service he received the Meritorious Service Medal and the Bronze Star Medal;

13 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
14 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his state as evidenced dramatically by his
15 practice which focuses on energy, utilities, environmental, and local government law,
16 specializing in electric, natural gas, and telecommunications regulations, and he also has a
17 robust economic development practice negotiating tax incentives from state and local
18 governments for his clients; and

19 WHEREAS, he is the Secretary of the German American Chamber of Commerce in Atlanta,
20 a member of the Energy Section of the State Bar of Georgia, and a member of the Atlanta
21 Bar Association, and he has been very active in the Georgia and Fulton County Republican
22 Parties serving on the campaigns of Governor Sonny Perdue and Lieutenant Governor Casey
23 Cagle and currently serving as General Counsel to the Buckhead Young Republicans and in
24 the Coverdell Leadership Institute Class of 2007; and

1 WHEREAS, he recently served on the Joint Study Committee on Fulton County which was
2 responsible for studying the conditions, needs, issues, and uses of the Fulton County
3 government structure and operation and addressing problems discovered by the Fulton
4 County Blue Ribbon committee; recommending legislation to address its findings; seeking
5 advice from private, institutional, and law enforcement experts and officials; and conducting
6 meetings to enable the committee to perform its duties and accomplish its objectives and the
7 purposes of House Resolution 351; and the committee reported its findings and made
8 recommendations for proposed legislation for 2008 legislative session; and

9 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
10 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
12 the members of this body commend Brad Carver for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and
13 dedicated service to the citizens of this state and extend to him their most sincere best wishes
