- 1 Recognizing and honoring the memory of Mr. W. Earl Marshall; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. W. Earl Marshall was recently inducted into the Houston County Teacher
3 Hall of Fame; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Hall of Fame honors those extraordinary teachers who have made a
5 significant difference in the lives of their students; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. W. Earl Marshall graduated from Perry High School in 1944, and after
7 earning his degree, he returned to Perry High School in 1951, where he taught science for 19
8 years, passing away in 2004 at the age of 77; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
10 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; his loyalty, competency, reliability, and
11 enthusiasm distinguished his superlative service to public education in this state; and
- 12 WHEREAS, his deep personal commitment to his duties as well as his great compassion for
13 the students he taught earned for him the respect and admiration of the people with whom
14 he worked.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
16 the members of this body honor the memory of Mr. W. Earl Marshall for his many decades
17 of efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated service to public education in Georgia.
