4 Teacher Hall of Fame; and

5 WHEREAS, the Hall of Fame honors those extraordinary teachers who have made a  
6 significant difference in the lives of their students; and

7 WHEREAS, Mrs. Dorothy Naomi Jones spent more than 25 years as an outstanding  
8 classroom teacher, teaching at Southside and Centerville Elementary Schools before passing  
9 away in 2001, at the age of 70; and

10 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
11 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; her loyalty, competency, reliability, and  
12 enthusiasm distinguished her superlative service to public education in this state; and

13 WHEREAS, her deep personal commitment to her duties as well as her great compassion for  
14 the students she taught earned for her the respect and admiration of the people with whom  
15 she worked.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
17 the members of this body honor the memory of Mrs. Dorothy Naomi Jones for her many  
18 decades of efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated service to public education in
