#### A RESOLUTION

1 Dedicating Veterans Boulevard in Glennville, Georgia; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper to provide for lasting memorials to their great  
5 courage and dedication.

7 GEORGIA that the members of this body commend the veterans of all ages and dedicate the  
8 portion of SR 301 in Glennville, Georgia, in Tattnall County, as Veterans Boulevard in honor  
9 of their great sacrifices on behalf of our country.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
11 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this  
12 resolution.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
14 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Glennville City Council  
15 and the Department of Transportation.
