### A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and remembering the life of Mr. Willie Lee "Bubba" Jackson, Sr.; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Willie Lee "Bubba" Jackson, Sr., was a beloved husband, a devoted father  
4 and grandfather, and an active citizen of the Milledgeville and Baldwin County communities;

6 WHEREAS, he was born in Baldwin County on January 19, 1926, the youngest of four  
7 children to the late James Jackson, Sr., and Dora Lee Pounds Jackson; and

8 WHEREAS, he served his country honorably in the United States Army during World War  
9 II, receiving several decorations while serving in the Pacific Theater; and

10 WHEREAS, his pride in his service to his country was reflected in his membership in the  
11 Warren Hawkins American Legion Post # 523 and the shining example he set for his family  
12 and friends; and

13 WHEREAS, he was united in holy matrimony on November 18, 1944, to Dennette Alene  
14 Odum and remained devoted to her throughout his lifetime; and

15 WHEREAS, together they created and maintained a loving home that was blessed with four  
16 daughters, one son, 19 grandchildren, 40 great-grandchildren, and one  
17 great-great-grandchild; and

18 WHEREAS, he was a faithful employee of Central State Hospital for 35 years; and

19 WHEREAS, God called Mr. Jackson to a peaceful rest and a life eternal on February 5, 2008;

1 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the life of this honorable Georgian be  
2 appropriately recognized.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
4 join together to honor and remember the life of Mr. Willie Lee "Bubba" Jackson, Sr., and  
5 extend to his family their most sincere condolences.
