A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Trion Fire Chief Steve Rosser; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the motto of the Trion Fire Department is "make a difference"; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the department once again lived up to its motto on September 26, 2006, by
4 saving two lives that day; and
- 5 WHEREAS, on that day, in an area near the Mount Vernon Mills, where several Trion
6 firefighters are employed, Fire Chief Steve Rosser and employee Eric Sparks detected the
7 odor of smoke; and
- 8 WHEREAS, upon investigating nearby houses, Chief Rosser discovered that the residence
9 at 235 11th street was burning; and
- 10 WHEREAS, due to the valiant efforts of Chief Rosser, despite the flames and smoke and
11 without his turnout gear, the two occupants of the building were successfully evacuated, and
12 a thorough search was made for any other persons who might have been in the building; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Trion firefighters arrived and extinguished the fire.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
15 the members of this body commend Trion Fire Chief Steve Rosser for his many contributions
16 to the welfare of his community and this state.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
18 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Trion Fire Chief Steve
19 Rosser.
