

**ADOPTED**

Senator Unterman of the 45th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Appropriations Committee substitute to HB 887 (LC 33 2609S) by*  
2 *inserting after the first semicolon on line 5 of page 1 the following:*  
3 to provide for automatic repeal;

4 *By striking lines 5 through 18 of page 3 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

- 5 (5) Recommend to the Governor and the legislature changes in law which would remove  
6 barriers to, or enhance the implementation of, this state's tobacco prevention strategy;  
7 (6) Make recommendations to the Governor and the legislature on the need for public  
8 information campaigns to be conducted in this state to limit tobacco consumption;  
9 (7) Encourage implementation of a coordinated, integrated, and multidisciplinary  
10 response to the tobacco use problem in this state, with special attention given to creating  
11 partnerships within and between the public and private sectors, and to the coordinated,  
12 supported, and integrated delivery of multiple-system services for tobacco users,  
13 including a multiagency team approach to tobacco prevention and education; and  
14 (8) Review the original Master Settlement Agreement to assess Georgia's continued

16 *line the following:*

- 17 (h) This Code section shall be automatically repealed on July 1, 2010."
