A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Howell Stephen Standridge, Jr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Howell Stephen Standridge, Jr., of Boy Scout Troop 149 of Athens, Georgia,
3 has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy
4 Scouts of America; and

5 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
6 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
7 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and

8 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
9 Howell Stephen Standridge, Jr., has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in
10 mastering the various special skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and

11 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout service project, Howell planned and led a team of scouts
12 and adults in an environmental awareness campaign on ground water issues, distributing
13 flyers and painting stencils on storm grates in several local neighborhoods; and

14 WHEREAS, as a scout, he has served in almost every possible leadership position, having
15 been Quartermaster, Den Chief, Patrol Leader, Instructor, and Senior Patrol Leader; and

16 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
17 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
18 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

19 WHEREAS, in a world which consistently seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the
20 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with
21 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
2 commend Howell Stephen Standridge, Jr., for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the
3 highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
4 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
