A RESOLUTION

Commending First Afrikan Presbyterian Church on the occasion of its 15th anniversary; and 1

2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the First Afrikan Presbyterian Church is now being led by the "transformative 4 and restorative" ministry of Dr. Mark A. Lomax, who, in 1993, accepted the charge to 5 establish a responsive and relevant faith congregation in the changing community of Lithonia, Georgia; and 6

7 WHEREAS, the commitment of its founding members provided both ministry and civic 8 service to the surrounding community which resulted in rapid congregational growth, 9 additional property development, the Vanessa Knight Education building, an active civic 10 role, and collaborative community action with other churches through Atlantans Building 11 Leadership and Empowerment (ABLE); and

12 WHEREAS, in 2003, the First Afrikan Presbyterian Church supported the establishment of 13 the First Afrikan Community Development Corporation to foster entrepreneurship, 14 educational achievement, improved family and personal health, and care for seniors; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lomax has also served on a number of community and ecclesiastical 15 16 committees to advance the tenets of liberation theology and justice for all people, and his graduate education and doctoral work provided the theological and social framework for the 17 development of an Afrocentric Christian Theology adopted by the founding community of 18 First Afrikan Presbyterian Church which has made it one of the fastest growing 19 20 congregations in the Atlanta Presbytery; and

- 21 WHEREAS, First Afrikan Presbyterian Church is a signature teaching ministry responsible 22 for community-wide experiences that generate opportunities for spiritual and cultural unity
- 23 through its Ancestral Walk, Conversations on Afrikan Spirit, John Henrik Clarke Community

- 1 Study, Kwanzaa Celebration, and other experiences offered through its Center for Afrikan
- 2 Biblical Studies; and
