#### A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and commending the Classic City High School Performance Learning Center for  
2 helping high school dropouts return to school and receive an education; and for other  
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the Classic City High School Performance Learning Center, which opened in  
5 2003, is an alternative for students who cannot attend school full time by offering  
6 "minimesters"; and

7 WHEREAS, students can take up to four courses in a "minimester," allowing students to earn  
8 credits as soon as they exhibit an 80 percent mastery of the material; and

9 WHEREAS, the Classic City High School Performance Learning Center also offers on-site  
10 child care which requires parents to take a parenting class in order to utilize the facility; and

11 WHEREAS, 150 students have graduated from the Performance Learning Center with  
12 one-third of those students pursuing postsecondary education options, 94 percent of students  
13 have improved their grades, and 97 percent of students have improved their attendance; and

14 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for this superlative program to be recognized for its  
15 contribution to the education of the youth in this state.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
17 the members of this body join in honoring and commending the Classic City High School  
18 Performance Learning Center for helping high school dropouts return to school and receive  
19 an education.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
21 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Classic City High  
22 School Performance Learning Center.
