A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Dr. Maxine Pinson Easom on the occasion of her retirement; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Maxine Pinson Easom has long been recognized by the citizens of Athens
4 for the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to
5 education and the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Dr. Easom is a loving wife to her husband, Dr. Kenneth Charles Easom, and a
7 devoted mother to her two daughters, Margaret and Merideth; and

8 WHEREAS, she obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree in business administration from
9 LaGrange College in 1966, a Master of Education degree in elementary education from the
10 University of Georgia in 1974, and a Doctor of Education degree in curriculum and
11 supervision from the University of Georgia in 1981; and

12 WHEREAS, she began her teaching career as a private piano teacher and then moved on to
13 work as an assistant teacher for the Head Start Program in the Clarke County School District;
14 an elementary school teacher at Barrow Elementary School; a graduate assistant at the
15 University of Georgia; an assistant coordinator of student teaching at the University of
16 Georgia; an elementary school teacher at Barnett Shoals Elementary School in Clarke
17 County; an adjunct instructor for the Department of Curriculum and Supervision at the
18 University of Georgia; an elementary principal at Gaines and Fourth Street Elementary
19 Schools in Clarke County; and a middle school principal at W. R. Coile Middle School
20 before becoming the principal of Clarke Central High School; and

21 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
22 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
23 dramatically by her many years of exemplary service in education and more recently as

1 principal of Clarke Central High School, serving in the same building in which she once
2 attended school during the 1960's; and

3 WHEREAS, her significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable patience
4 and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of her students and
5 the citizens of her community and this state have earned her the respect and admiration of
6 her colleagues and associates; and

7 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
8 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and she has earned numerous awards in
9 recognition of her outstanding service as an educator from organizations across the country;

12 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
