## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the United States Congress to pass the National Museum of the American Latino
- 2 Commission Act; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the contributions of the Hispanic community to the United States date back to
- 4 1565, when the Spanish established the first permanent settlement in United States territory
- 5 in St. Augustine, Florida; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Latinos in the United States have influenced and enriched this country since its
- 7 founding and continue to make important contributions; and
- 8 WHEREAS, there exists a need for a home for historical artifacts, images, and stories
- 9 documenting over 500 years of Latino contributions to our nation; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives on February 6, 2007, passed by
- 11 unanimous voice vote the National Museum of the American Latino Commission Act for the
- 12 creation of a commission to study the feasibility of and to establish a plan for a new national
- 13 museum for this purpose; and
- 14 WHEREAS, identical legislation has been introduced and favorably reported out of
- 15 committee in the United States Senate.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 17 this body does hereby urge the United States Congress to adopt the National Museum of the
- 18 American Latino Commission Act for the important purpose of furthering the
- 19 commemoration of Latino contributions to the United States of America.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 21 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to each member of the Georgia
- 22 congressional delegation.
